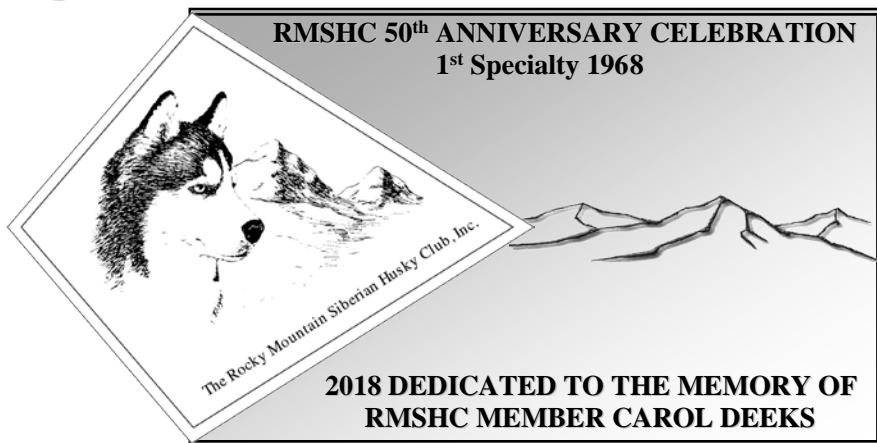

Additionally, rather than crating your dogs next to your grooming table, there will be an area between the grooming area and the show rings that will be provided for crating dogs. Crates must be stacked. No soft-sided crates will be allowed. Maximum crate size allowed is 36-L x 23-W x 26-H
Since this is the first time we have used this show site, we are uncertain how much electrical "load" the grooming area can accommodate. Please limit your blow dryer use and share with fellow exhibitors to the extent possible.

ROUTES TO SHOW SITE

There are **MANY** ways to get to the Show Site -- it is probably best to use your **GPS** or **MapQuest** to determine the best way for your path of travel. However, here are a couple of routes:

FROM THE SOUTH:

Exit at I-25 to I-76 East -- Left at I-76 / Hwy 85 fork -- North to 124th Ave -- Left on 124th to Show Site (on right)

FROM THE NORTH:

I-25 South to Hwy 7 -- Exit east on Hwy 7 to Hwy 85 -- South on Hwy 85 to 124th Ave Right on 124th to Show Site (on right)

OR North or South on Hwy 85 to 124th Ave -- Left or Right on 124th to Show Site (on right)
