- In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the show committee
- For duplicate entries

- If the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club or show secretary

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

The A.K.C. will collect the above fees for each 1st Entry of a dog & each Additional Entry of the same dog in regular & non-regular recordable single entry classes in all A.K.C. Licensed & Member Club Events. Event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all fees for the A.K.C. & payment of all fees to the A.K.C. as stipulated in *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Ch 11, Sec 2*

The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause, and no person shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

There will be no drilling or intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises. **NO DOUBLE HANDLING** will be permitted at this show. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Show Committee.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. There is no provision for unentered dogs at this show. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be picked up at the show, none will be mailed. All awards will be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging, to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the rightful winner of the award. The Show Secretary should be advised of any award discrepancies.

Effective January 1, 2015 -- USE OF RAMPS: A CLARIFICATION

BACKGROUND The appropriate place to individually examine dogs during breed judging is designated by each parent club and AKC does not pre-empt their authority in this regard. **RAMP BREEDS** A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the show superintendent/ show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. Designated ramp breeds may be examined on the ground (table if applicable) or on a ramp during breed, group and Best in Show judging at the sole discretion of the judge, not the exhibitor. Examination for a breed must be consistent; therefore the entire entry in that breed is to be examined on the ground (table) or on a ramp. By Board approved policy, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs and Chows must be judged on the ramp in all conformation competition associated with AKC conformation dog shows or at which AKC conformation titles may be earned. This policy extends to Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. The list of Table and Ramp breeds can be found on the AKC Website under Conformation Judges – Announcements. **ALL OTHER BREEDS** Breeds not designated as either table or ramp breeds may only be examined on the ground. **EMERGENCIES** In emergency situations, with the approval of the Show Chair, breeds customarily examined on the ground may be examined on a ramp, not on a table. An emergency is defined as a temporary condition that arose immediately prior to or at a dog show. Convalescence from a medical procedure, illness and recuperation from injuries are examples of conditions that are not emergencies. The emergency use of a ramp may be allowed on a day and may be extended to include a cluster as well as judging either a group and/or Best In Show. (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund).

BEDLINGTON TERRIERS ARE A TABLE DESIGNATED BREED

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION:

See current edition of the *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* or *contact the Show Secretary* for Best of Breed Entry Requirements; Transfer Procedures, etc.

A.K.C. GRAND CHAMPION TITLE POINTS:

Effective May 12, 2010 – AKC Grand Champion Title Points may be awarded to Best of Breed / Variety; Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed / Variety & SELECT DOG & SELECT BITCH See current edition of the *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* or *contact the Show Secretary* for additional information on the Grand Champion Title Requirements

AWARD(S) OF MERIT:

The judge may, at his / her discretion, recall into the ring **UP TO THREE** dogs or bitches to receive **AWARDS OF MERIT**. These Awards are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES Multiple Dog Entries

STUD DOG CLASS for stud dogs and two of their get Stud dogs may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes, or if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST BE ENTERED** in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Stud dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the Regular Fee plus the Additional Class fee if the Stud dog is entered in another class. Owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be the owner of the get. Judging to be on the merits of the get. Get must be entered in another class in this show. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the breed.

BROOD BITCH CLASS

same as for the stud dog *except* substitute brood bitch for stud dog and produce for get.

NOTE: Chapter 11, Section 8, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* provides that castrated males **may be entered** as Stud Dog and spayed females **may be entered** as Brood Bitch.

BRACE CLASS Fee is \$21.00 as a unit

Effective 1/1/05 – **Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers.**

Both dogs in the Brace must have at least one common owner.

Dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry.

If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is **NOT ENTERED** in another class at this show, it must be entered for **“BRACE CLASS ONLY”**, with the appropriate individual entry fee **\$12.00 plus “Brace as a Unit” Fee**. In making entries for “Brace Class Only”, full particulars must be given on an Official AKC Entry Form.

If the dog is entered in another class, Brace must be marked as an “Additional Class”. If more than one Brace is entered by an individual owner, please designate dogs comprising each Brace as “Brace # 1”, “Brace # 2”, etc.

Please submit “Brace” entries together.

NOTE: As the judge’s decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch & Brace Classes is based upon the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these classes.

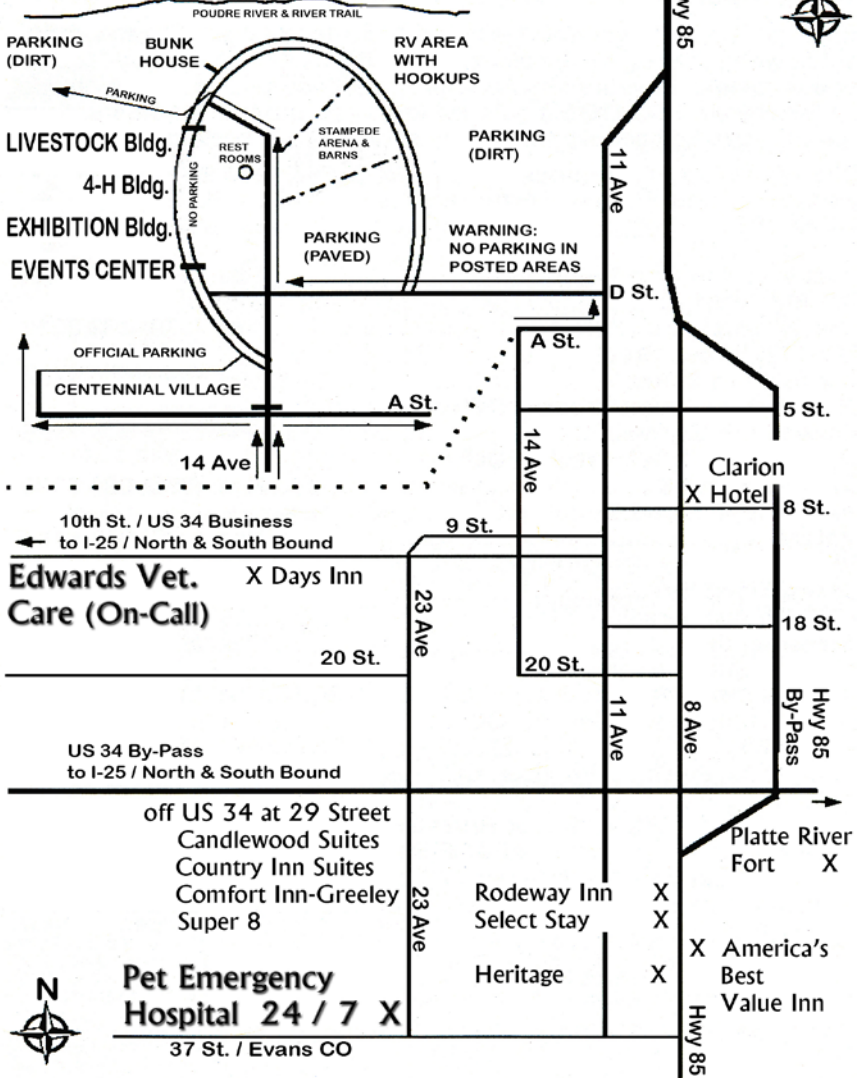
